2025**Exploring the Temples**

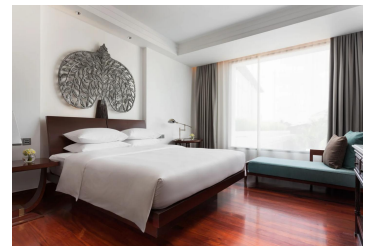
