# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Depart the port for Kinkakuji Temple in northern Kyoto – as it comes into view, you'll soon see why it is known as the Golden Pavilion. The upper floors of this Zen temple are completely covered in gold leaf, which makes for a striking reflection in the waters of the tranquil pond on which it sits. Admire its beauty as you stroll through the surrounding peaceful gardens.Next, you'll enjoy a delicious kaiseki lunch – a convivial banquet featuring multiple courses all beautifully presented – as a geisha entertains. Afterwards, we'll move on to Tondaya, a Kyoto townhouse turned lifestyle museum, and don kimonos for a traditional tea ceremony before returning to the ship.
