A nature-first, wildlife-spotting boat trip through Sitka Sound, combined with an on-shore gourmet Alaskan seafood feast and storytelling by an indigenous Tlingit elder

Framed by the Baranof Island peaks and majestic Mount Edgecumbe, Sitka Sound is a pristine, coastal wildernesses. Set sail on an intimate expedition vessel that glides past golden kelp forests, countless coves, and a smattering of islands, keeping eyes peeled for bald eagles, humpback whales, sea otters, and sea lions. There's also a high likelihood of glimpsing brown bears prowling the glacier-carved fjord's shoreline, hunting for salmon. Go ashore at Dove Island Lodge for a four-course seafood lunch, made using the freshest native ingredients, before gathering round a crackling fire for tales about the rich heritage of the region, told by a Tlingit elder.

- A food preparation demonstration of freshly caught salmon and seafood by the Dove Island Lodge chefs
