Landmarks of History and Hidden Saigon

After leaving the ship at Hiep Phuoc Port, travel into the heart of Ho Chi Minh City for an exploration of the events and places that shaped modern Vietnam. Begin at the Reunification Palace, where the Fall of Saigon marked a pivotal moment in the nation's history. Continue to the Saigon Central Post Office, an architectural masterpiece of the French colonial era, before visiting the War Remnants Museum, where the compelling exhibits provide insight into the Vietnam War and its lasting legacy. Continuing our tour through the city, view the former CIA apartment building associated with one of the conflict's most iconic images. Enjoy a traditional Vietnamese coffee before visiting a neighborhood residence concealing a secret weapons bunker once used by resistance forces. Following a delicious lunch at a local restaurant that showcases regional flavors, transfer to Park Hyatt Saigon for an evening at leisure.

Chinatown Traditions and Cultural Encounters

After enjoying a leisurely breakfast at the hotel, journey into the atmospheric streets of Cho Lon (Chinatown), one of Southeast Asia's most fascinating cultural districts. Wander through narrow alleyways lined with centuries-old buildings and discover neighborhoods where daily life continues much as it has for generations. Continue to a local artisan community renowned for producing Buddhist amulets and devotional statues using traditional techniques passed down through the years. A visit to a historic Chinese temple dating from 1809 offers insight into the customs, rituals, and beliefs that remain integral to the Chinese-Vietnamese community in Ho Chi Minh City. Later, enjoy free time at Ben Thanh Market, a bustling marketplace known for handicrafts, textiles, coffee, spices, and local specialties. Following lunch at a local restaurant, transfer to Hiep Phuoc Port to rejoin your cruise.
