Arrive in the Masai Mara

You will be met at the pier and transferred to Moi International Airport for your flight to the Masai Mara. The journey will go via Nairobi, where you will enjoy an early lunch at Karen Blixen Coffee Garden between flights. On arrival at Kichwa Tembo Airstrip in the Masai Mara, you will be driven to Sanctuary Olonana, a journey of about 30 minutes.



Sanctuary Olonana is the height of luxury in the heart of the bush. Fourteen spacious new suites, with deeply comfortable king-sized beds, have been designed to reflect the inspiring natural surroundings. A particular feature is the full-height glass doors, which fold open to reveal magnificent views of the Mara River, which you can enjoy from your daybed on the open deck.

In the late afternoon you will enjoy your first game drive on the savannah – alongside its neighbor, the Serengeti, this area is home to the most diverse ecosystem in Africa. A spectacular array of wildlife lives here, including almost 600 species of bird, so you might encounter leopards, buffalo, elephants, rhinos and lions as well as many other animals. You will return to the lodge to relax and dine.

Sanctuary Olonana's 14 exceptional new suites, at least 130 square meters (1399 square feet) in size, flaunt clean lines and organic materials. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please note:

There is a strict luggage limit of one (soft-sided) bag weighing less than 33lbs per person. Guests carrying luggage over this weight limit will have the option to leave it at the Abercrombie and Kent office in Nairobi.

The hot-air balloon ride, walking safari, and night game drive are chargeable options.

This program is unsuitable for children under 8 years old. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Photography of government installations and uniformed officers is prohibited. No flash photography is permitted inside sites. Please seek guidance from your tour guide.

Please dress appropriately for hot weather - cool, comfortable, cotton clothing is recommended. Evenings can be cool, so we recommend guests bring something warmer such as a light sweater. In respect of local culture and customs, guests should dress conservatively with shoulders and knees covered. We also advise you wear comfortable, flat walking shoes and bring a hat and sunscreen. A pair of binoculars is useful.

The activity level is moderate and game drives are on dusty, uneven and bumpy terrain, making this program unsuitable for wheelchair users, people with major mobility issues or back problems, and those with serious dust allergies.

Exiting vehicles while in the game park is strictly prohibited.

Guides speaking languages other than English are limited and subject to availability at time of booking.

Wildlife sightings are likely but not guaranteed.

Included:

All flights, transfers, accommodation, meals, entrance fees, and activities as stated.

Excluded:

Any travel, meals, drinks, and activities not specified in the tour description.

Any personal expenditure, for example souvenirs, laundry, phone calls etc.

Visa fees.

Optional activities including the hot-air-balloon ride, walking safari, and night game drive.
