Arrive in the Masai Mara

You will be met at the pier and transferred to Moi International Airport for your flight to the Masai Mara. The journey will go via Nairobi, where you will enjoy an early lunch at Karen Blixen Coffee Garden between flights. On arrival at Kichwa Tembo Airstrip in the Masai Mara, you will be driven to your camp, a journey of about 15 minutes. In the late afternoon you will enjoy your first game drive on the savannah – alongside its neighbor, the Serengeti, this area is home to the most diverse ecosystem in Africa. A spectacular array of wildlife lives here, including almost 600 species of bird, so you might encounter leopards, buffalo, elephants, rhinos and lions as well as many other animals. You will return to the camp to relax and dine.

Explore the wild, from dawn to dusk

Your day will start early with a warm drink so that you're refreshed and ready to join your guide on a thrilling morning game drive. Hyenas, giraffes, gazelles, hippos and more will be among the animals stirring into life. Return to camp for a late breakfast and a relaxed day at your leisure, including lunch and afternoon tea, before wildlife-watching begins again. An evening game drive as dusk falls will also offer memorable sunset views. Back at camp there is time to relax, before a convivial dinner. Today, you will have the option to pay for activities including a hot-air balloon ride at sunrise, and walking safari.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please note:

There is a strict luggage limit of one (soft-sided) bag weighing less than 33lbs per person. Guests carrying luggage over this weight limit will have the option to leave it at the Abercrombie and Kent office in Nairobi.

The hot-air balloon ride and walking safari are chargeable options.

This program is unsuitable for children under 8 years old. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Photography of government installations and uniformed officers is prohibited. No flash photography is permitted inside sites. Please seek guidance from your tour guide.

Please dress appropriately for hot weather – cool, comfortable, cotton clothing is recommended. Evenings can be cool, so we recommend guests bring something warmer such as a light sweater. In respect of local culture and customs, guests should dress conservatively with shoulders and knees covered. We also advise you wear comfortable, flat walking shoes and bring a hat and sunscreen. A pair of binoculars is useful.

The activity level is moderate and game drives are on dusty, uneven and bumpy terrain, making this program unsuitable for wheelchair users, people with major mobility issues or back problems, and those with serious dust allergies.

Exiting vehicles while in the game park is strictly prohibited.

Guides speaking languages other than English are limited and subject to availability at time of booking.

Wildlife sightings are likely but not guaranteed.

Included:

All flights, transfers, accommodation, meals, entrance fees, and activities as stated.

Excluded:

Any travel, meals, drinks, and activities not specified in the tour description.

Any personal expenditure, for example souvenirs, laundry, phone calls etc.

Visa fees.

Optional activities including the hot-air balloon ride, and walking safari.
