### Please note:

The roads within the game reserve are gravel, and certain areas can be bumpy. This program is not recommended for guests with back problems, and those with walking difficulties may find it challenging to get in and out of the open vehicles. For safety reasons, children under the age of 6 are not permitted on the open vehicles. Please note that wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed. Consult your local Embassy for the most current visa requirements for Namibia, and ensure you have two blank pages available in your passport for entry. Each guest is allowed one soft-sided bag (20 kg) and one carry-on bag (7 kg).
